Activity 14.5A: Food Chains and Food Webs

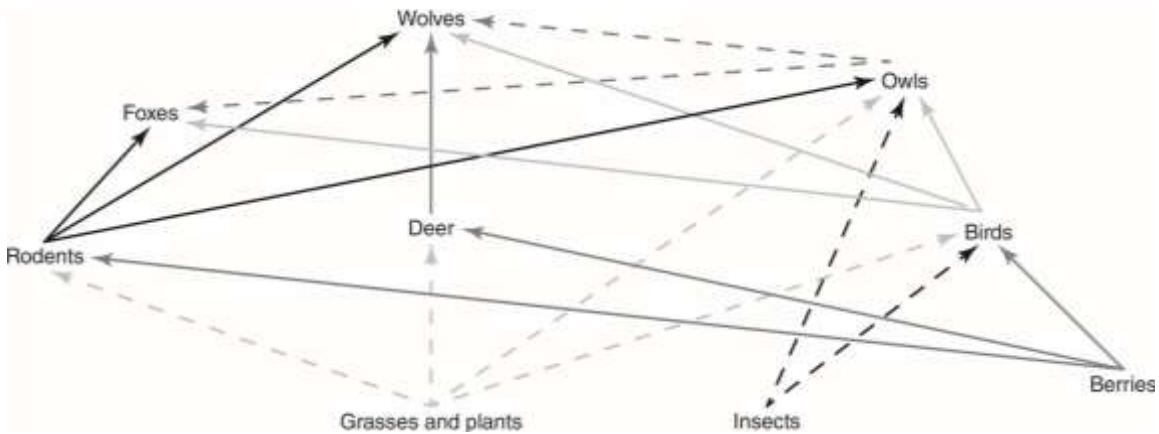
Instructions
